
Can we remind all parents if you have not brought in a tooth brush and tooth paste in to bring some in please in a separate bag with your child's name on it. Thank you

Mounted Police


This went really well, the children really enjoyed seeing the Police on their horses and asking lots of questions.

We are celebrating all the children leaving us to go to Reception in September and all our preschoolers will be joining in the festivities.


We will have our ceremony in our school gym and we would like to invite parents/carers to come and celebrate this with us.
