Spare clothes

Can we please ask that your child is brought to nursery with at least 1 spare pair of clothes. As much as we try to keep the children nice and clean this isn't always possible.

Sometimes the children are having so much fun at the water tray, the painting and messy play stations that even with an apron on they get wet or messy and need to be changed.

Can we also ask that toilet training children bring in LOTS of changes of clothes. Accidents happen and we must ensure that children are changed into dry un-soiled clothes straight away – if a child doesn't have their own clothes to change into this can cause distress for the child.

If you leave a bag here with a change of clothes can you please check these are appropriate for the hot weather we are having.

This week in Tiger room we are going to continue focusing on Jungle animals. We are going to do lots of craft activities and looking at the book called Dear Zoo.


REMINDER:

Tapestry
